

School Supplies, Room 2520, 2010-2011

Dear Students and Parents,

It may be helpful to think of the supplies in two groups. In the first group are things that students may have left over from previous years, or about which they may have strong preferences (color, style, etc).

Group One, please supply these items on your own.

- Three Ring Binder (2" rings), or an accordion organizer. No Trappers please.
- Subject dividers, about 10
- Set of colored pencils, thin colored markers, or crayons
- A mechanical pencil (0.7 mm size lead), or #2 wooden pencils
- 2 blue or black pens, erasable is good
- Pencil box or other container for small loose items
- Calculator (simple four function is enough.)
- Box of tissues (large, please!)
- 2 or 3 glue sticks, or one large
- 3 x 3 inch (approximately) Post-It style notes
- 12 inch/30 cm ruler
- Scissors

We have some calculators and scissors for general use in the classroom, so if you prefer you can borrow these items as needed. You should have one of everything to start off and then could fill in the remainder as needed over the year.

In Group Two are items that are included in what I will call the basic supply fee. Everyone will need to pay this fee, \$27.00, to cover these items which we will be using throughout the year. I have included 900 sheets of note book paper and 500 3x5 cards in here. We are able to get these items at a discount from Office Depot. It is a lot easier for me to handle the papers if they are all the same size, plus, having the supply here eliminates having kids run out of paper. Any leftover paper will be divided equally and sent home at the end of the year.
