Dear Parents,

Starting school as a kindergartner is an exciting event. I am looking forward to sharing this first school experience with you and your child. I hope to see you and your child at the Kindergarten Orientation on Wednesday, August 31st at 9:00 AM. At that time, I'll be able to give you more information about the Kindergarten program at Marvista. **Please bring the completed pink Information Sheet to the Orientation.**

Below is a list of school supplies needed for the year. Please help your child have these purchased and ready to bring on the first day of school.

Items for your child's individual use – please label with your child's name:

- 1 box crayons (16 color size)
- 1 pair children's scissors (please make sure they are sturdy and cut well. Fiskars are great.)
- 1 pink pearl eraser
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 school box (plastic 5" x 8") to hold supplies
- 3 pencils (sharpened)
- 4 pencil grippers

Please bring 1 box of crackers, (Graham, Ritz, or soda crackers).

Choose to bring only 1 item for class use and please do not label it:

- 1 box of tissue
- 1 set of washable markers or colored pencils
- 1 package of paper lunch sacks
- 1 package of 9" white paper plates (optional)

In addition, please send a check for \$4.00 made out to Marvista School to cover extra projects during the year. Every day your child will need to bring a back pack that is large enough to fit 9" x 12" papers and a lunch pail. Please label your child's coat, lunch pail, and backpack. The backpack is an assured way of getting important papers and creations home.

Your child's day will begin at 9:10 AM and end at 3:40 PM. Hot lunch will be served the first day, and the cost is \$2.50 for lunch which includes milk or you may buy a meal ticket for any amount. If your child would rather bring a lunch from home, milk may be purchased separately for 50 cents.

If you have any questions regarding school supplies, I will be covering this information at the orientation. I look forward to meeting you and your child on Wednesday, August 31st.
